What is Slow Art Day?

Slow Art Day is a global event with a simple mission: help more people discover for themselves the joy of looking at and loving art.

Why slow?

When people look slowly at a piece of art they make discoveries. The most important discovery they make is that they can see and experience art without an expert (or expertise) - and that's an exciting discovery. It unlocks passion and creativity and helps to create more art lovers.

Although photography is allowed (no flash please), start this experience by putting away your phone. Focus your attention on one work of your choice, try to see it as a whole, then pick out small details, moving around it if you are able to do so. Then either draw the work as a whole, or the smaller details that stand out to you. After you are done drawing, think about any details that you missed during your first look.





Pick a different work of your choice, look at it slowly for 10 minutes without distraction, and ask yourself the following questions.
What feelings or emotions does the work produce or evoke?
Do the materials help convey the same emotions or feelings?
Look at other works that are near the one you picked. How do they compare to the work you selected? How do the sizes of the work affect your viewing?

Once finished, if you haven't already, look for Sofia and Emma in the gallery to discuss your thoughts!
